

New Rules and Regulations Now Effective

The Alabama Board of Court Reporting's proposed amendments to Rules and Regulations have now become effective and are posted in their entirety on the ABCR Web Site (please see link below). These amendments were advertised to the public for comment in June of 2018, public comments received were reviewed by the ABCR, and final rules with changes were certified to the Legislative Services Agency making them effective on December 4, 2018.

Please note that Chapter 257-X-3-.01 - Temporary Licensure rule amendments are currently still advertising for public comment (public comment period ends on December 5, 2018). Therefore, the new Rules and Regulations effective now will not reflect those final rules as the process for those amendments have not yet concluded. Specifically, public comments will be reviewed by the ABCR at its' next Board meeting and final rule amendments will then be filed for certification. This final rule amendment will also be posted on the ABCR web site and broadcast e-mailed to licensees upon their adoption.
