There are simple on-screen instructions to help guide you through the process. This is a secure site (safer than sending a check in the mail), and you will be able to use an e-check, debit, or credit card. You will also be able to print your renewed certificate immediately.

Please note that no one may work in Alabama as a Court Reporter with an expired CCR.

Again, we thank you for your cooperation in renewing on-line. This feature is the most expeditious way to renew a license and keeps processing costs low, which in turn will keep your license fee low.
